The visiting team, composed in accordance with the regulations set down in **HAC Resolution 2010/10/VI** and under consideration of the accreditation criteria set down in said resolution, has conducted a site visit to the training sites. In the visit, the team inspected those wards that conduct medical care in the areas in which sixth-year students receive training: *internal medicine; surgery; neurology; psychiatry; obstetrics and gynecology; and pediatrics*. The training program was discussed with the heads of the wards as well as the head of the hospital.

	HAC RESOLUTION 2016/3/VII A (accredited) On condition that the accreditation criteria continue to be met throughout, the accreditation of the hospital training site is granted until December 31, 2021 Over one third of the hospital units have been accredited, therefore the hospital is granted the title of Accredited Teaching Hospital .

Compliance with the accreditation requirements:

1. The *Ilsan Paik Hospital* (opened in 1999) is an **accredited training center in Korea**, which participates in the education of medical students. It is a teaching hospital of the *Inje University* (founded in 1932) which has eight faculties included Medical College.
2. *Ilsan Paik Hospital*, more specifically the departments being the subjects of this review, **filled out the accreditation questionnaire**, on the basis of which it can be said that this is an institution with a **large number of patients** and where **highly qualified physicians conduct medical practice**, 80% of them with PhD degrees. The hospital has 700 beds on 17 floors, with a staff of 1500.
Based on the accreditation questionnaires the following hospital wards are in compliance with the HAC criteria: *internal medicine; surgery; neurology; psychiatry; obstetrics and gynecology; and pediatrics*.
3. The heads of the hospital wards and the physicians under their charge are **regularly involved in medical student training**. Around 100 freshman medical students are enrolled each year with a current enrollment of 613 students in the six years. The hospital has its **own two years resident-training program** in which the heads of the main clinical subjects participate. **Each ward or department has over three specialists (with over 15 specialists)** as well.
4. In the six fields mentioned above the academic requirements and list of competences required for the diploma have been agreed on with the heads of the institutes and the HAC concurs that the **hospital is able to ensure the fulfillment of the requirements set** down in the documents. The hospital can host about five students from Hungary per year and is able to ensure dormitories on request.
5. For the examination of the infrastructure of the training the expert team visiting the sites reviewed not just the wards but also the Neonatal Intensive Care Center, the hospital's Intensive Treatment Center and the Cardiovascular Center. The facilities **fulfill the requirements** and are actually of particularly high quality.
6. Based on the site visit, accreditation may be granted to the following units at *Ilsan Paik Hospital*:
internal medicine
surgery
neurology
psychiatry
obstetrics and gynecology
pediatrics

Based on the requirement that **at least one third of the departments should be accredited** is fulfilled, the institution is awarded the title of *accredited teaching hospital*.

	HAC RESOLUTION 2016/3/VII A (accredited) On condition that the accreditation criteria continue to be met throughout, the accreditation of the hospital training site is granted until December 31, 2021 Over one third of the hospital units have been accredited, therefore the hospital is granted the title of Accredited Teaching Hospital .

Compliance with the accreditation requirements:

1. The *Yonsei University Hospital* (opened in 2005) is an **accredited training center in Korea**, which participates in the education of medical students.
2. Yonsei University Hospital, more specifically the departments being the subjects of this review, **filled out the accreditation questionnaire**, on the basis of which it can be said that this is an institution with a **large number of patients** and where **highly qualified physicians conduct medical practice**, 90-95% of the permanent teaching staff has PhD degree. The details, regarding number of beds, physicians, etc., can be found in the filled-out questionnaires.

Based on the accreditation questionnaires the following hospital wards are in compliance with the HAC criteria: *internal medicine; surgery; neurology; psychiatry; obstetrics and gynecology; and pediatrics*.

3. The heads of the hospital wards and the physicians in their charge are **regularly involved in medical student training**. They enroll around 100 freshman medical students a year with the current enrollment at 613 students in the six years. The hospital has its **own two years resident-training program** in which the heads of the main clinical subjects participate. **Each ward or department has over three specialists (with over 15 specialists)** as well.
4. In the six fields mentioned above the academic requirements and list of competences required for the diploma have been agreed on with the heads of the institutes, and the HAC concurs that the **hospital is able to ensure the fulfillment of the requirements set** down in the documents. It is ready to accept 6th-year students from Hungary who are given dormitory housing. Financing for the comprehensive ex-
am-year is to be negotiated later.
5. The size of the campus is impressive. The hospital, with 23 floors, is fully equipped. In addition, a ten-floor "Cancer Building" was completed last year. For the examination of the infrastructure of the training the expert team visiting the sites reviewed not just the wards but also the College of Medicine Clinical Simulation Center, where in the Simulation Laboratory, in addition to providing life support, allows students to practice a range of medical skills. The facilities include several doctor's offices, where students practice with actors on how to deal with patients. In the new Cancer Building excellent diagnostic and patient care is going. The facilities **fulfill the requirements**, and are actually of particularly high quality. The hospital was granted international accreditation, and is up for its first re-accreditation this year.
6. Based on the site visit, accreditation may be granted to the following units at *Yonsei University Hospital*:

internal medicine
surgery
neurology
psychiatry
obstetrics and gynecology
pediatrics

Based on the requirement that **at least one third of the departments should be accredited** is fulfilled, the institution is awarded the title of **accredited teaching hospital**.

Based on the information provided in the report the HAC's position is a positive one with respect to the Korean hospitals visited, and it supports granting access for Hungarian medical students to the high-quality training at these sites.
